## Skydive Bovec, Slovenia

### Event Description

Imagine spending a week in magical mountains, where each morning you can choose to spend your day skydiving or try out one of many other exciting mountain sports under professional guidance... this is an event where you can do exactly that. You will enjoy the spectacular Slovenian landscape from the sky, from the water and even underground. You can challenge yourself physically and mentally in many different ways. Or you can join our top British Skydiving coaches to learn and progress in your chosen discipline. Your choice. And the best thing: you will have a magical week no matter what the weather is.

### Drop Zone

Skydive Bovec is the biggest drop zone in Slovenia, located in the heart of the Soča valley. In addition to skydiving, the valley is packed with numerous adventures and adrenaline sport activities, making it a fantastic place to bring family and friends.

The Bovec drop zone provides jumpers with fantastic facilities and a selection of aircraft to utilize from their fleet, making it an ideal place to learn skydiving or build on your skills in small or large groups alike. Skydive Bovec regularly hosts various civilian training groups and remains one of Parabellum's favourite destinations in Europe for its unrivalled views.

### Location

Bovec is located in the Northwest part of Slovenia in Soca Valley. Soca Valley is a remarkably beautiful river valley with its source in the heart of the Triglav National Park. The upper stretch of the valley runs through the beautiful Julian Alps and is a magnet for adventure sports lovers – offering a dizzying abundance of river activities (rafting, kayaking, canyoning) and mountain activities.

As well as the many outdoor activities and the beautiful sightseeing routes, Bovec also offers great restaurants, comfortable hotels, apartments and many tourist attractions. Bovec also sponsors several outdoor social events in its historic main square, meaning there is always something to enjoy for everyone.

The nearest airports are Venice Marco Polo and Ljubljana Slovenia. Both are 2.5 hours drive to Bovec town centre.

## How Does It Work?

The event is designed for you to come to practice your own discipline within the sport, with the opportunity to try out or learn another one. Whether you are a skydiver that wishes to try freeflying, tracking or to just get your knees back in the breeze, this is your event.

If you have never skydived before and would like to become a part of this awesome sport and our big family, then this event is definitely for you!

Our staff and drop zone's infrastructure enable you, as a student skydiver or experienced jumper, to focus solely on learning and progression with the minimum of administrative issues.

## Experience Level

All levels of experience are welcome, from student skydivers to experienced jumpers. This year, skydivers will still make up the largest part of the event (AFF Students, Free Flyers, Tracking and Formation Skydivers) but mountain bikers, kayakers, canyoneers, cavers, paragliders, speedflyers and nature lovers are also very welcome. No minimum level is required for any of these sports.

## Cost

A **non-student** participant pays a one-off registration fee of £150 for the event, which covers all administration fees associated with arranging for British skydiving coaches, dropzone administration, load organising and evening socials. We will also arrange for all transportation / car hire and accommodation (at cost) with the group if you wish to do so.

For experienced skydivers, a £50 deposit upon registration is required to secure a place and the rest of the balance at least two weeks before the trip.

**The AFF course** for the event will cost £1,549, which covers AFF course only. Please refer to our AFF Full Course Price page for more information regarding what is included in the cost. A deposit of £500 should be paid on registration, with the rest of the balance paid at least two weeks before the trip.
